

What You Need to Know about Applying for an Achievement Scholarship

- 1. This is a GREAT opportunity for you to be awarded money toward your college education!
- 2. MOSTe Achievement scholarships are a 1-year scholarship and are disbursed in 2 payments beginning Fall 2018.
- 3. Last year, scholarships ranged from \$1,100-\$3,000. Each year is different and there are no guarantees on the minimum/maximum or number of scholarships given out, but that should give you an idea.
- 4. You must be a graduating senior who will be attending college.
- 5. You must be eligible based on the criteria on the next page.
- 6. Do not submit your application late.
- 7. All applications must be typed and not hand-written.
- 8. Answer every question and don't leave anything blank.
- 9. If the question requests dates, make sure you include the month and year.
- 10. If you need additional space to write, you can submit an extra page with your response.
- 11. Spelling and grammar matter.
- 12. You will need 2 recommendation letters, so ask now. If you leave it until the last minute, you will run out of time. Examples of people you can ask for recommendation letters are teachers, coaches, pastors, mentors, and counselors. Pick people who know you well because they will do a better job of telling us about how wonderful you are. Do not ask family members.
- 13. When writing your essay please keep in mind that it is your opportunity to tell the scholarship committee about you. We don't all have the benefit of knowing you personally. We will be basing our decisions on your application and essay, so make sure it represents you well.
- 14. Everyone who applies for a scholarship will be required to interview with the scholarship committee. We typically select 2 days in May (TBD) depending on the number of applicants.
