

What You Need to Know about Applying for an Incentive Scholarship

- 1. This is a GREAT opportunity for you to be awarded money toward your college education!
- 2. MOSTe Incentive scholarships can range from \$250-\$1000. If you are selected, you will be notified in June. Scholarships are not given out until you graduate high school and are enrolled in college.
- 3. You must be in 8th grade.
- 4. You must be eligible based on the criteria on the next page.
- 5. Do not submit your application late.
- 6. Make sure you print legibly and neatly.
- 7. Answer every question and don't leave anything blank.
- 8. If the question requests dates, make sure you include the month and year.
- 9. If you need additional space to write, you can submit an extra page with your response.
- 10. Make sure that you are the one answering questions and writing the essay. It's ok to have someone proofread it for you, but what you submit should be in your own words.
- 11. Spelling and grammar matter.
- 12. You will need 2 recommendation letters, so ask now. If you leave it until the last minute, you will run out of time. Examples of people you can ask for recommendation letters are teachers, coaches, pastors, and counselors. Pick people who know you well because they will do a better job of telling us about how wonderful you are. Do not ask family members. Do not ask group mentors.
- 13. Make sure that your parent SIGNS the application.
- 14. When writing your essay please keep in mind that it is your opportunity to tell the scholarship committee about you. We don't have the benefit of knowing you personally. We will be basing our decisions on your application and essay, so make sure it represents you well. It's important to answer the question by telling us about your financial need and why we should consider you.
- 15. If you want us to email you the application, please e-mail Corina at <u>corina.crawford@moste.org</u> and request a soft copy.
